

ePoster session instructions

Essential information

ePosters must be submitted in advance through our dedicated online submission platform. All presenting authors will receive personalised invitations to this platform.

Participants may be using handheld recording devices/livestreaming to the internet during sessions. If you have any concerns regarding permissions, please address these at the beginning of your presentation. All submitted ePosters will be added to congress app and uploaded to the congress archive at a later date.

Format requirements

ePosters should be saved as a PDF, on a single page and in A0 format, portrait orientation. We recommend you use Office 2019 or earlier version.

Image files need to be inserted into the poster using the PowerPoint Insert function. You cannot use videos or moving images.

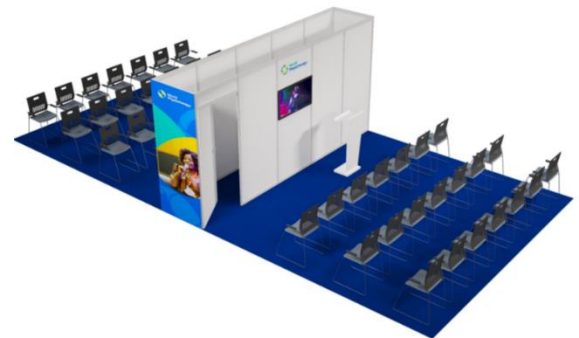
Preparation on site
